Social Empathy Initiative

The "Social Empathy Initiative" represents a comprehensive approach to fostering empathy, understanding, and social responsibility within the framework of the Institute. This initiative integrates three different activities last five years i.e. Shramanubhav Shibir, Seva Vasti Survey, and Nashik Integrated Platform for Covid Response (NIPCR).

Shramanubhav Shibir:

Shramanubhav Shibir is one of the distinctive characteristic programs at our institution, in collaboration with Volunteer Organisation Vanvasi Kalyan Ashram. Shramanubhav Shibir provides solutions by storing rainwater above the ground naturally through check dams and constructing artificial reservoirs, and cement dams. There is an acute shortage of even drinking water during the summer in many tribal villages of Peth Taluka Nashik District.

Aim/Objectives:

- Shramanubhav Shibir is a step towards the betterment of Vanvasi villages water harvesting and water literacy is a majorly discussed issue these days.

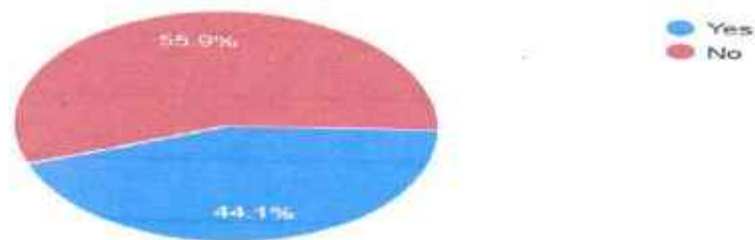
Objectives:

The Practice:

- A total of Six DMI staff were a part of the NIPCR team, which developed an online platform for Doctors & Hospitals based on responses to a questionnaire.
- Every staff member was assigned a fixed number of Hospitals from Nasik city for data collection about the availability of resources.
- Online Meetings were conducted for hospital feedback and collected data with vaccination details.
- DMI staff members were given the name of COVID YODHHAS.
- They provided all information regarding NIPCR activity to Hospitals and doctors through social media, Text & Phone Calls.

Outcomes:

- By actively engaging in the NIPCR activity, DMI demonstrated its commitment to uniting responsible citizens and stakeholders in Nashik District to combat the COVID-19 pandemic.
- DMI facilitated the optimal utilization of available resources to overcome the crises posed by the pandemic.





Seva Vasti Survey

The Institute focuses on community development for underprivileged and marginalized communities. One of their key initiatives is Seva Vasti's work, which involves providing essential services and support to individuals living in slums. Through its Seva Vasti work, the Institute aims to improve the living conditions of slum residents and empower them to create a better future for themselves and their families.

Objectives:
