
### MCA (Masters in Computer Application)














# Shree Ram Pran Pratishtha Sohala








#### Workshop on Start-up and Entrepreneurship

Fig. 1: Number of Students Appeared & Passed during A.Y.2023-24





Fig.2: Percentage Result of each Programme




